			Office SupportThis includes greeting visitors, showing them where to find the sign in sheet, and the location of the animals. Also, you can answer telephone calls and take messages for the appropriate individuals.
TLCThis fun job includes caring for the animals by walking, socializing brushing, bathing, and feeding them.			
Kennel AssistantThere is a great deal of work that our shelter staff completes each day. This includes cleaning and sanitizing the kennels and cages, washing the floors, cleaning up the grounds, laundry, etc. Assisting them with these every day tasks is a big help.			
TransportationWe need volunteers to drive animals to and from vet offices in the morning and transporting animals to and from offsite events. You must be 18 years old and have a clean NYS driver's license.			

Maintenance

_____Facility upkeep is essential in running a successful shelter. We always need help with the basic outdoor tasks such as mowing the lawn, weed whacking, landscaping, shoveling, snow blowing, etc. Also, if you are handy in carpentry or repair work, please let us know.

Special Events

______We try to bring animals into the community as much as possible. Not only does this higher their chance of adoption, it also allows them a break from the shelter. We currently have wonderful relationships with vendors and pet stores that often ask us to be present at their events. We need volunteers to help man the Wanderers' Rest table while others are needed to handle the animals in the public. These volunteers also will assist in the adoption process at the site. Offsite events are typically run solely by volunteers, so it is imperative that we have reliable and trustworthy people who are willing to help. These events are wonderful because they also allow exposure and fundraising for the shelter.

Dog Training

_____For those of you who have special skills and/or training in dog obedience, we welcome you aboard! Typically, most of our dogs need some attention and training. If you are willing to spend some one and one time with our dogs it would greatly increase their chances of being adopted.

Foster Care

This opportunity is for volunteers 21 and up. Volunteers may fill out a foster parent application if they are interested in fostering animals at home. If they qualify, this rewarding experience will allow you to take home an animal for a certain period of time. There you will care for the animal until it is adopted or ready to be brought back to the shelter. The amount of time a person could potentially foster varies from two weeks to three months. If interested, you would receive more detailed information involving foster care.
